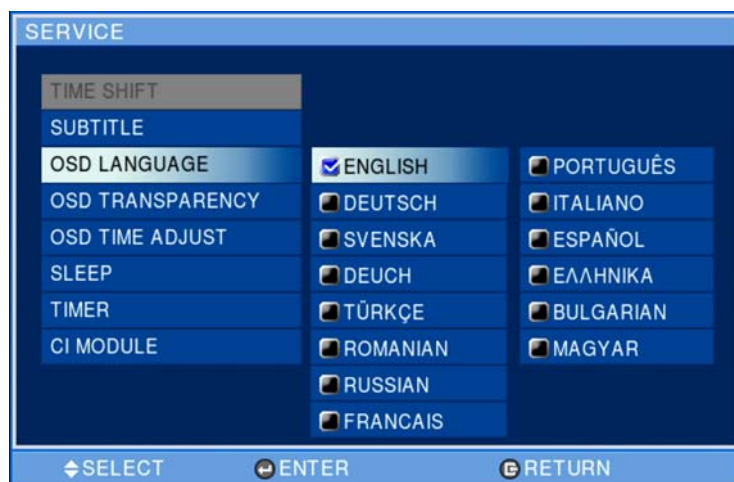
## Hyundai AH-3110 Quick Start Guide:

To configure your AH-3110 simply connect it to both your terrestrial aerial and satellite dish. Connect it to your TV also and turn it on.

You will see:



Press the Menu button on the remote control:



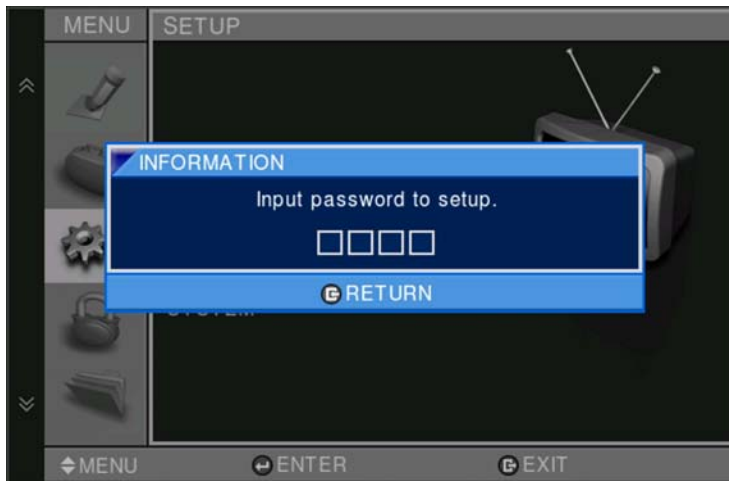
Press Menu Twice to get to the Main Menu:



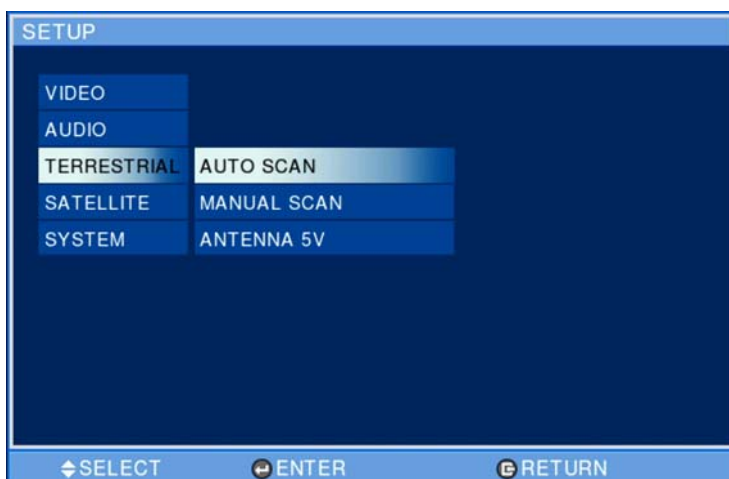
Use the Down Button to Select the Setup Menu:



Enter the Password (0000)



Scroll to TERRESTRIAL and select AUTO SCAN



After the SCAN you will see the channels found:



Scroll to SATELLITE and select LNB:



The Following example shows how to set the AH-3110 up for Freeview on the OPTUS D1 Satellite:

Your LNB may be one of these:



10750 MHz



11300MHz



11300MHz

Select the OPTUS D1 Satellite and change the High L.O. to match the LNB L.O. Frequency shown for you LNB on the previous page.



Once Changed Press MENU twice then Select EDIT/SCAN



At this point you may wish to press OK then use the Orange button to add the SBS TP (12648MHz 12600 KS/s Vertical Polarity) and Press Red to save.



Then Press Menu and then the Green Button and select Free and the press Enter



After the SCAN you will see the channels found:



Press Menu twice and then scroll to Edit Program



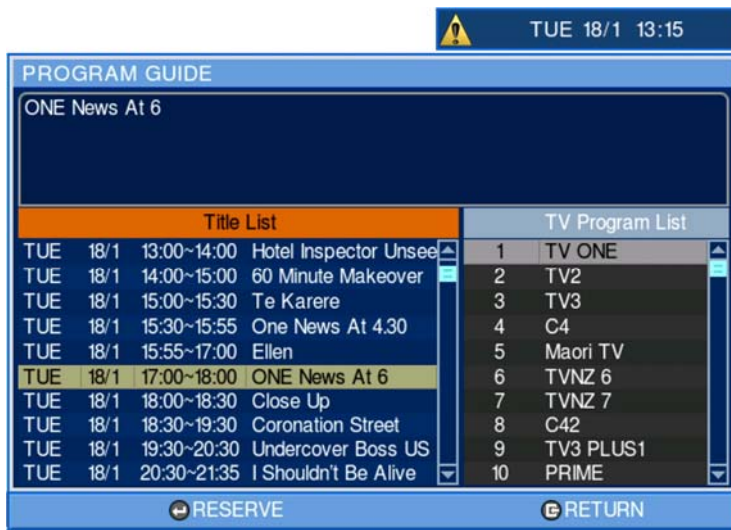
Select EDIT TV Program by Pressing OK twice.

The TV Channels found will not be in the correct order we recommend reordering the Channels to the order you would like. There will be some additional channels found which you may or may not want:

- Multiple versions of TV One and TV2 e.g. on the 12671MHz TP TV One and TV2 broadcast by Sky TV.
- Weather – The Sky Weather Channel Background Music.
- Various Test and Reserved channels

The Freeview Satellite Service Broadcasts a full 7 day EIT EPG, this can be used to schedule both satellite and terrestrial recordings:

e.g. Press EPG and use the satellite service to select the program you wish to record (One New At 6pm in this case)



Press Enter to make the reservation if you wish you can select the Terrestrial version on TV ONE instead to the Satellite version. Press the red button to save the reservation.
